


Checklist for content creators

REPORTING YOUR
ONLINE INCOME
→ IS EASIER
THAN YOU THINK!



If you make money online as a content creator, you're generally considered to be a self-employed person who runs their own business.

➤ Throughout the year

- Keep track of your income either by:
 - using appropriate accounting software
 - hiring a tax professional (accountant, tax advisor, etc.)
- Record all your **income** and **keep all supporting documents**, such as invoices and contracts or agreements with brands and partners. Income sources you have to report include:
 - monetary payments
 - gifts and donations
 - sponsorships
 - the market value of promotional gifts (e.g. PR packages) you received and kept, even if you didn't promote the product
- Record all your **deductible expenses** and **keep all supporting documents**, such as your invoices. Deductible expenses include:
 - part of your cellphone plan
 - costs to buy equipment (tripod, camera, etc.)
 - some travel expenses (tip: keep a log of all travelling for content creation)

Important: You must keep all records and supporting documents for six years after the last taxation year they cover.

➤ When you do your taxes

- 1 Finalize the accounting of your **income and deductible expenses**.
- 2 Get all your **supporting documents** together.
- 3 Calculate your **taxable business income** in either of the following ways:
 - Complete form ([TP-80-V](#)), *Business or Professional Income and Expenses* (for help completing the form, see guide ([IN-155-V](#)), *Business and Professional Income*).
 - Provide us with a financial statement showing all your income and expenses.
- 4 Carry the result to line 22 of **Schedule L** and then to line 164 of your **income tax return**.

➤ Consumption taxes

If your business income for a given calendar quarter or in the four preceding calendar quarters exceeds \$30,000, you must register for the GST/HST and the QST. To learn more, click [here](#).
